

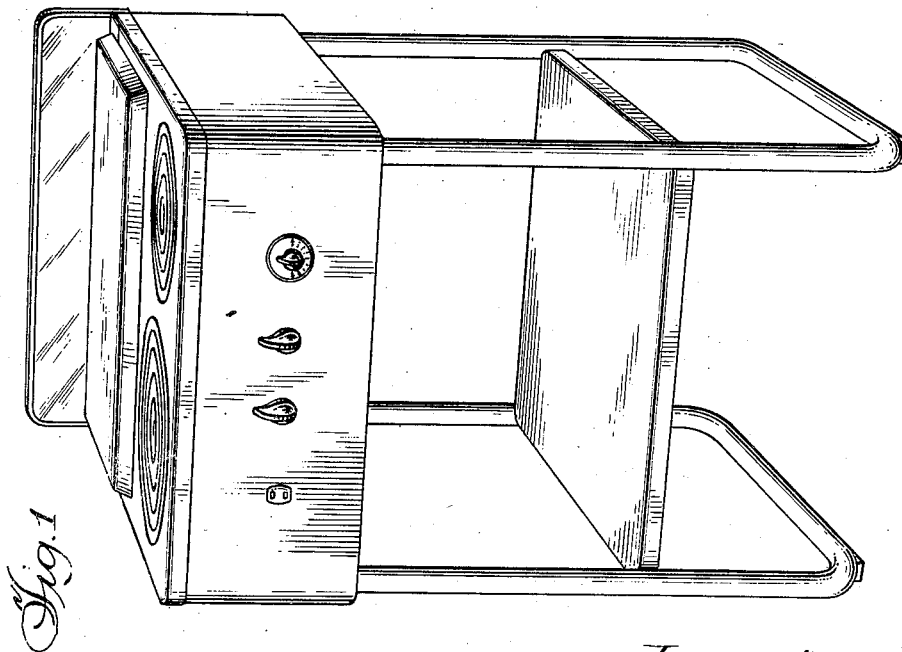
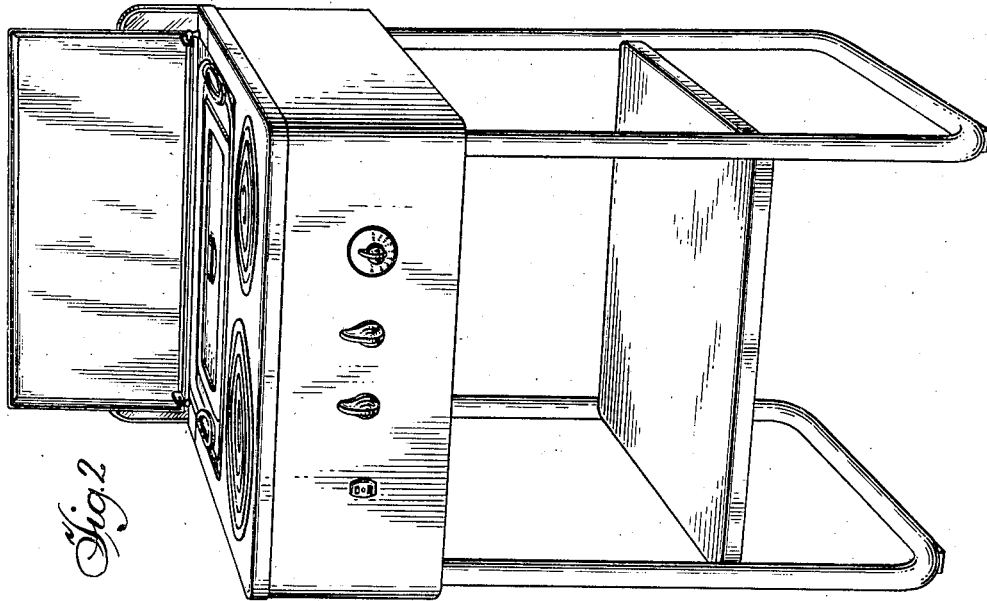

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Herbert T. Burrow, a citizen of the United States, residing at Beaver Dam, in the county of Dodge and State of Wisconsin, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Cooking Stove, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.

Fig. 1 is a perspective view of a cooking stove

showing the new design. The opposite end of the cooking stove is substantially like the end shown.

Fig. 2 is a perspective view of the same with the cover in open position.
