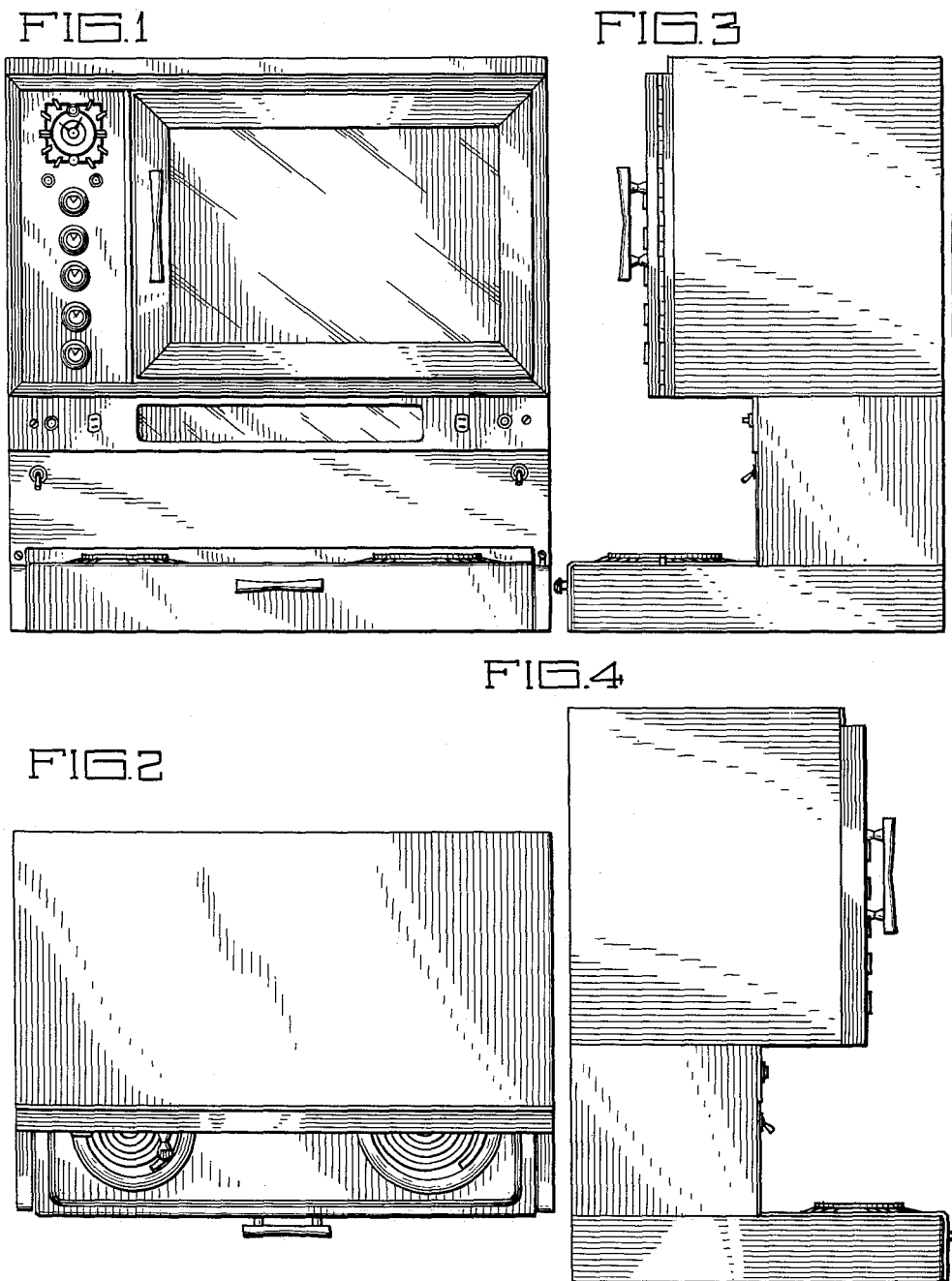

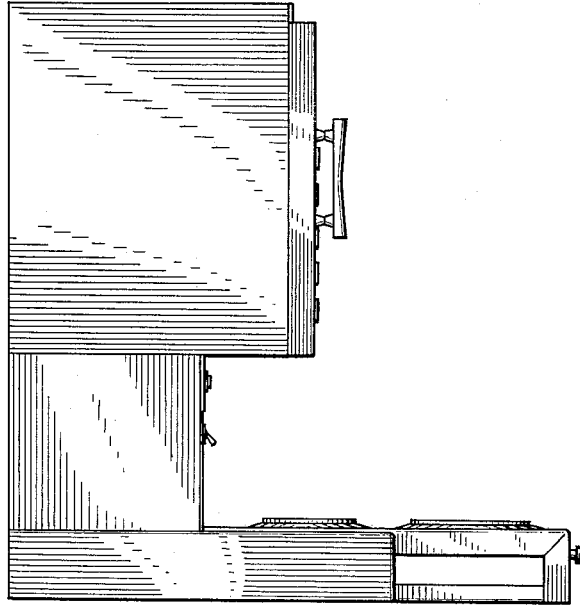

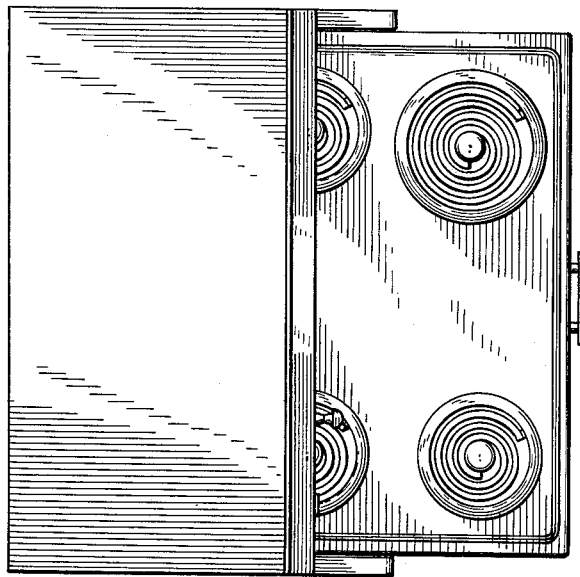

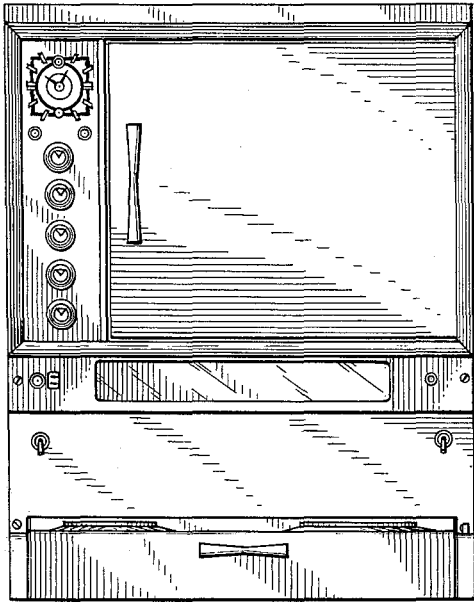

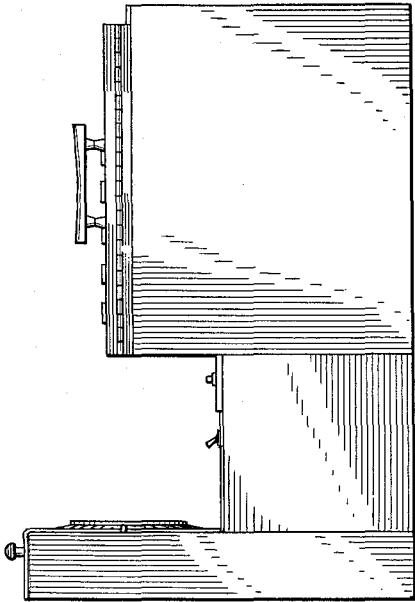

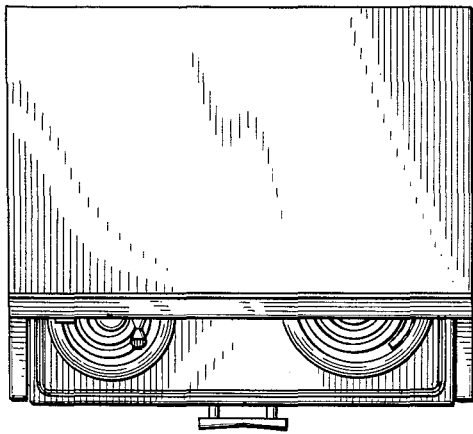

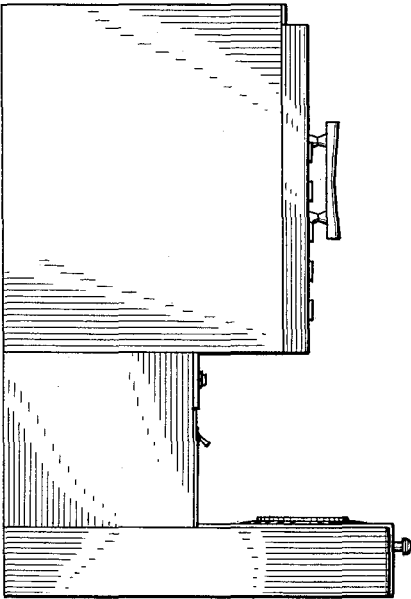

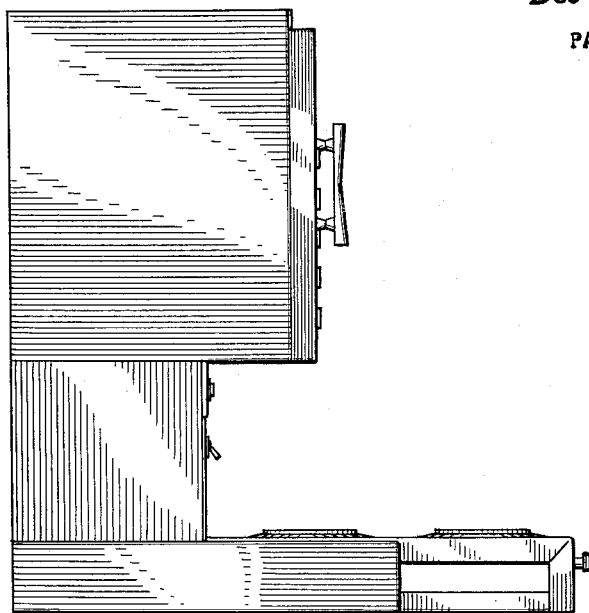

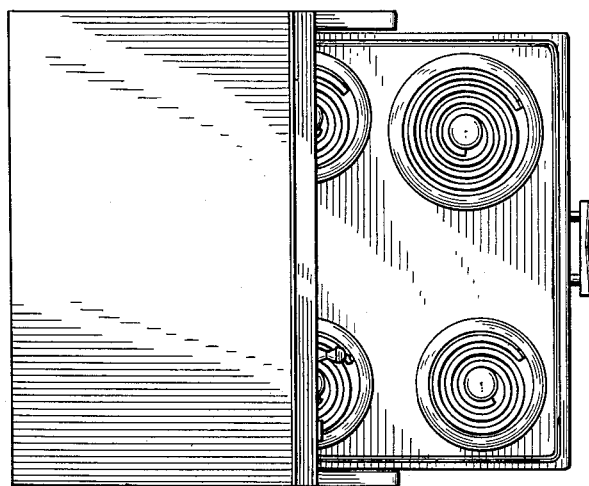


FIG. 1 is a front elevation of a cooking range embodying my new design and comprising one embodiment of my invention;

FIG. 2 is a plan view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a right side elevation thereof;

FIG. 5 is a left side elevation showing the cooking units in their forwardly extended position;

FIG. 6 is a plan view of the range in the position shown in FIG. 5;

FIG. 7 is a front elevation of a cooking range embodying my new design and comprising another embodiment of my invention;

FIG. 8 is a plan view thereof;

FIG. 9 is a right side elevation thereof;

FIG. 10 is a left side elevation thereof;

FIG. 11 is a left side elevation showing the cooking units in their forwardly extended position; and

FIG. 12 is a plan view of the range in the position shown in FIG. 11.

The rear and bottom of each embodiment are conventional and free from ornamentation.

This application is a continuation of my two earlier filed applications, Serial No. D. 61,077 and Serial No. D. 61,078, filed June 22, 1960, and now abandoned.
