

STATEMENT.

To the Commissioner of Patents:

Malleable Iron Range Company, a corporation duly organized under the laws of the State of Wisconsin, and doing business at 715 North Spring Street, in the city of Beaver Dam, county of Dodge, in said State, has adopted and used the trade-mark shown in the accompanying drawing, for GAS RANGES, COAL RANGES, COMBINATION GAS AND COAL BURNING RANGES, AND COAL-WOOD RANGES, in Class 34, Heating, lighting, and ventilating apparatus, not including electrical apparatus, and presents herewith five specimens showing the trade-mark as actually used by applicant upon the goods, and requests that the same be registered in the United States Patent Office in accordance with the act of February 20, 1905, as amended.

The trade-mark has been continuously used and applied to said goods in applicant's business since June 25, 1921.

The trade-mark is applied or affixed to the goods by means of transfers, the mark being thereafter heat treated to render the same permanent.

And the undersigned hereby appoints George Bayard Jones, (Regis. No. 9437), 1530 Marquette Building, Chicago, Illinois, its attorney, with full power of substitution and revocation, to prosecute this petition, to receive the certificate, and to transact all business in the Patent Office connected therewith.
