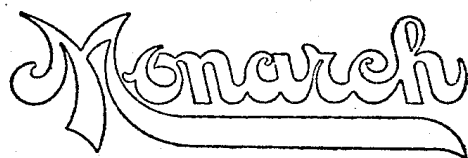

STATEMENT

To the Commissioner of Patents:

Malleable Iron Range Company, a corporation duly organized under the laws of the State of Wisconsin, and doing business at 715 North Spring Street, in the city of Beaver Dam, county of Dodge, in said State, has adopted and used the trade-mark shown in the accompanying drawing, for **ELECTRIC REFRIGERATORS**, in Class 31, Filters and refrigerators, and presents herewith five specimens showing the trade-mark as actually used by applicant upon the goods, and requests that the same be registered in the United States Patent Office in accordance with the act of February 20, 1905, as amended.

The trade-mark has been continuously used and applied to said goods in applicant's business since May 9, 1931.

Applicant is the owner of renewed trade-mark registration No. 63,856 of July 9, 1907.

The trade-mark is applied or affixed to the goods by means of transfers, the mark being thereafter heat treated to render the same permanent.
