STATEMENT.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that the MALLEABLE IRON RANGE Co., a corporation duly organized under the laws of the State of Wisconsin, and located in the city of Beaver Dam, county of Dodge, in said State, and doing business in said city of Beaver Dam, has adopted for its use the trade-mark shown in the accompanying drawing.

The trade-mark has been continuously used in the business of said corporation since the year 1899.

The class of merchandise to which the

trade-mark is appropriated is Class 34, Heating, lighting and ventilating apparatus, not included in Class 21, and the particular description of goods comprised in said class upon which said trade-mark is used is ranges other than gas stoves, oil stoves, gasoline or vapor stoves, and vapor burners and ovens.

The trade-mark is displayed on the articles by being formed on a name plate secured thereto.
